### MILLENNIUM PIECE

Although the Parish Council do not have a formal lease for the Millenium Piece, we are still renting it on an ad hoc basis and are proposing to manage the vegetation. Happily, a Parishioner is still giving his time and skills to manage the hedge / cut the grass but the vegetation along the river on both sides and within the river itself needs to be managed by cutting. A couple of years ago the Fakenham Area Conservation Team (FACT) came out to help with this and we had a morning of work where we cut and raked up the sward to give the wildflowers a chance to develop - over time this type of management would have a positive effect but at present its really just a start. We are proposing that we might do this again in late October if the Parish Council agree. Therefore if anyone would like to register to join FACT with this project (ie become a temporary member and volunteer and thereby be covered by their insurance and guidance – this is free to do) please let Sarah the Clerk know and you will be very welcome - FACT provide tea and coffee and you can decide how long / hard you want to work - everyone is welcome - it would be nice to try to make it an annual event if we can.

#### **RIVERFLY SCHEME**

The Norfolk Rivers Trust have conducted two Riverfly Scheme data collection on the River Burn at The Common, Burnham Thorpe.
