HIGHWAYS

Reducing the speed limit – Cllr Andrew Jamieson of Norfolk County Council gave an update on the A149 project which Burnham Thorpe was hoping to be part of. This is making slow progress.

Goodricks – The Borough Council have attended and inspected the potholes and surface of Goodricks.

The Clerk is awaiting an update of the action to be taken.

MILL LANE/BACK LANE

A site meeting has taken place with Highways. Highways have considered signage on the narrow road to alert vehicles of pedestrians walking. Firstly, Hoklham are being contacted to enquire if they would allow a permissive path from Back Lane to the public right of way off Mill Lane. If this is not possible, then Highways would place pedestrian warning signs to alert oncoming traffic. Highways would also consider placing "SLOW" markings on the road. This will be discussed at the next meeting once a reply from Holkham has been received.
